

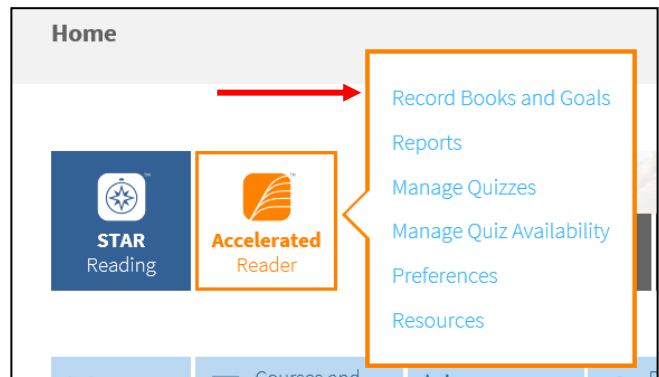
Entering Reading Practice Goals

NOTE: A teacher manages goals for his/her classroom. The teacher-librarian, in consultation with the staff, determines the marking periods. The marking period must be set before goals can be activated. Marking periods may not overlap.

IMPORTANT: Goals should be set in consultation with the student.

Follow the steps below to enter three types of goals—Average Percent Correct, Points, and Book Level.

- Enter the goals for each students:
 - **Average % Correct:** Usually left at 85%
 - **Points:** Enter the number of points the student is expected to earn within the reporting period.
 - **Book Level:** Keep the book level goal set to the lowest end of the ZPD.


Note:

- The **GE (Test Date)** and **Suggested ZPD** will be populated if a student has taken a STAR Reading test before the goals are entered.
- If you identify the amount of **Daily Reading time** (the GE and Suggested Date must be populated), the program will automatically calculate the suggest points goal.
- If the GE and Suggested ZPD are not populated, you may use the **Goal Calculator** link to help you determine a starting point.
- Once you have student data from the **Reading Practice Diagnostic Report** and **Student Record Report**, you should use this information...along with a student conference...to help inform realistic goals.
- Remember to include students in the setting of goals so that they take ownership for them.


- From the Renaissance Learning main home page, select < Reports > under the Accelerated Reader tab.


